

# 1915(i) Medicaid Home and Community-Based Services

## Free services to help you be independent



NC Medicaid’s new “**1915(i) services**” help you live more independently in your home and community, and give your caregivers the support they need.

These services are for people with serious mental illness, severe substance use disorders, traumatic brain injuries or intellectual/developmental disabilities.

### Services Include:



#### Respite care

Breaks for caregivers, including overnight and weekend care



#### Supported Employment

Helps you find and keep a job that’s right for you



#### Individual Placement and Support Services

Job help for those with severe mental illness or substance use disorders



#### Individual and Transitional Support

Helps you find housing, manage your finances and more



#### Community Living and Support

Helps you learn to perform daily activities, like bathing and dressing



#### Community Transition

Helps you move from an institutional setting back to your community
