ACHIEVE is a virtual Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) program provided through the Exceptional Children's Assistance Center (ECAC), designed to support high school students with disabilities as they transition from school to adult life. The program is funded through NC EIPD (formerly VR) and offered at no cost to eligible students.

Program Requirements:

Students must:

- Be between the ages of 14 through 21
- Currently be enrolled in high school or in college/technical school
- Have a disability
- Have access to a computer and internet connection
- Be willing to learn and use Zoom 1 hour per week
- Have a clear desire to participate in the ACHIEVE Transition program
