It is an opportunity to learn and observe how DeafBlind individuals navigate the park with the support of a Support Service Provider (SSP) or a CoNavigator (CN).

An SSP supports DeafBlind individuals by providing visual and environmental information, human guide assistance, and support with accessing their surroundings safely and comfortably.

A CN works alongside a DeafBlind individual in a more collaborative and shared experience. Co-navigation involves exploring the environment together, sharing information through touch-based communication and interacting with the surroundings as partners.
