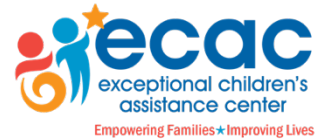


Exceptional Children's Assistance Center
2020 Family Engagement Month Call for Proposal
RFP Submission form



Purpose of Request for Proposal: To celebrate Family Engagement Month the Exceptional Children's Assistance Center (ECAC) is calling for proposals from K-12 public schools in NC. The purpose is to highlight innovative and effective practices that engage families of children with disabilities in their child's learning. Two public schools will be awarded up to \$1,500.00 each to support their project. Projects that are chosen will be required to create a short video to highlight their strategies and share with other schools.

Eligible Applicants: This application is open to K-12 public schools in North Carolina.

Population to be Served: Families of children with disabilities identified under IDEA or Section 504.

Number of Grants to be Awarded: There are two categories of awards, Title I Schools and Non-Title I Schools. There will be one grantee in each category.

Grant Award Amount: Each grantee can receive up to \$1500.

Grant Period: February 1, 2021 – June 12, 2021

Application Deadline: The RFP Submission form must be sent electronically to Broberts@ecacmail.org no later than 11:59 P.M EST Friday, January 8, 2021. Submissions received after the deadline will not be considered.

Application Requirements:

- One application per school
- All items in the RFP submission form must be completed
- 12 font typed, 350 word limit per question
- Signature required from Principal

Grant Requirement

- Each grantee will be required to create a short video (5-6 minutes) to highlight their strategies and share with other schools.
- No supplanting of other federal, state, or local funds.

Grant Criteria

- Must demonstrate how this proposal encourages families of children with disabilities to be involved in their child's learning..

Allowable Activities:

- Examples include planning, materials, supplies and equipment, incentives, transportation, joint professional development with families, and evaluation.

Selection Process

Applications will be scored by a review panel comprised of ECAC staff, parents, and community representatives to determine grant awards. The scoring rubric details the points assigned to each part of the application

Scoring Rubric

Selection Criteria (50 Total Points)	POINTS
1. Culturally and linguistically responsive	5
2. Engages families in planning and implementation	10
3. Innovative strategies	10
4. Clear implementation plan	10
5. Specific outcomes	10
6. Plan for measuring outcomes	5

Notification Process: An email will be sent to the Principals of the grantees on Friday, January 29, 2021 notifying them of the decision.
