

How Can ECAC support NC families of Children with DeafBlindness?

Individualized support is available to families of children with DeafBlindness from birth through 21 years of age.

- **Information and Referrals:** Access state and national materials. Receive a free family resource packet in English or Spanish.
- **Consultation:** Receive individualized assistance from a DeafBlind Parent Educator.
- **Training:** Attend state and national conferences, participate in webinars and in person workshops. Apply for financial support to cover conference expenditures.
- **Networking:** Meet and connect with other parents and professionals working with DeafBlind children.



DeafBlindness is a spectrum and often times it includes additional disabilities.



DeafBlindness is a unique disability that involves the combination of hearing loss and visual impairment.
