



What Medicaid Means for Your Child

What is Medicaid?

Medicaid is a health insurance program. Different insurance companies offer different Medicaid plans. When you sign your child up for Medicaid, you can either choose or be assigned a plan.

What Benefits Does Medicaid Provide My Child?

No matter what Medicaid plan they have, ALL children with Medicaid can get these services for free:

Benefit	What's Covered
Health Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Well-child and sick visits with a primary care providerMental health servicesSpecialty care for complex needsPrescription medications
Dental and Vision Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Dental cleanings twice yearlyEye exam and prescription glasses once yearlyOther dental and vision services as needed
Rides to Appointments	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Rides to and from medical appointments (call Member Services 1-2 weeks before a visit)
Extra Medicaid Plan Benefits	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Resources like baby supplies, asthma supplies, and more*

***Note:** Each Medicaid plan offers different benefits. Call Member Services to learn about extra benefits.

How Do I Get and Use These Benefits?
