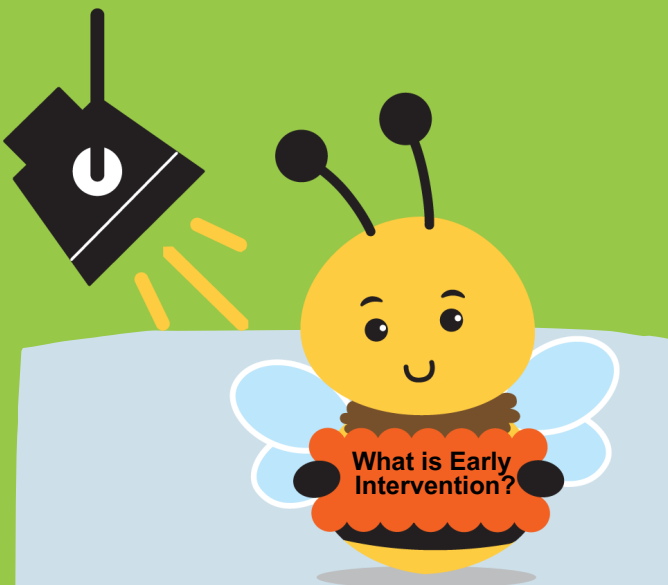


Infant-Toddler Program



The North Carolina Infant-Toddler Program (ITP) provides support and services for the development of infants and toddlers with special needs or developmental delays up to age 3 and their families. This service and support is known as the Early Intervention program.



Early Intervention helps you learn how to support any delays in the development of your infant or toddler. You may notice differences in the way that your child sees, listens, moves, talks, learns, plays or interacts with others. It can even affect how they are able to handle daily activities.



We believe YOU are your child's best teacher, and you know your child best. As such, you will be part of a team along with service providers to create a plan. The plan will focus on helping your child and your family build skills based on individual needs.



Did you know?

The Children's Developmental Services Agency (CDSA) coordinates these services locally. There is NO COST for service coordination or evaluation. Other services may be charged on a sliding fee scale or paid for by Medicaid and/or your private insurance.
