
#### HAVE QUESTIONS ABOUT NC MEDICAID?

It's important to know who to contact with your specific questions or concerns. Here is who you should call and when:

#### YOUR HEALTH PLAN

Contact information varies by health plan.

- To change your Primary Care Provider (PCP).
- To request a ride to a medical appointment (Non-Emergency Medical Transportation -NEMT)
- To request a new Medicaid ID card

#### YOUR LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES (DSS)

- To apply for Medicaid (Or you can apply in person or online through <u>ePASS</u>)
- If you have questions about
   Medicaid coverage, eligibility or recertification
- To update your mailing address,
   contact or other personal information
- To request Non-Emergency
   Medical Transportation (ride to a
   medical appointment) for NC
   Medicaid Direct or EBCI Tribal
   Option beneficiaries
- To request a new ID card for NC Medicaid Direct or EBCI Tribal Option beneficiaries.
